

# Event Host Responsibilities

Muay Thai Ontario  
Supporting Amateur Muay Thai in Ontario



- Gloves, head guards, shin guards, & elbow guards (See Rules, section 8.1);
- Cleaning of athlete equipment (antibacterial wipe/spray);
- Individual to sign off on gloves;
- Individual to sign off on hand wraps (See Rules, section 8.2);
- Individual for glove running;
- MTO regulation boxing ring (See Rules, section 10);
- Ringside equipment (See Rules, section 11);
  - Steps;
  - Stools (2 per corner);
  - Gong (with striker) or bell;
  - Wooden clapper for 10 second warning;
  - 3 ringside judges tables;
  - 1 ringside Chief Official's table;
  - Ringside official seating (2 per judge's table, 4 at Chief Official's table);
  - Ringside crowd barriers to be placed from judges tables/around the ring;
- Videographer;
  - A digital recording of all contests is preserved and submitted to the Muay Thai Ontario Office to keep the safety of your event on record should any litigation occur;
- Medical doctor (see Medical Handbook);
- Table for doctor during medicals and weigh-ins;
- Ice for injured athletes;
- Table for MTO officials by the medical doctor;
- Paperwork;
  - Approved contest list at available at weigh ins and on each official's table;
  - Scorecards;
- Officials accommodation, parking, and travel expenses;
- Food and beverages for the officials;
- Additional insurance, if;
  - The event includes alcohol service;
  - The event includes activities other than the production of Muay Thai competition (dancing, other physical contests, etc);
    - This insurance be purchased through MTO at a discount or through 3<sup>rd</sup> party (\$2 million liability is the minimum requirement);
- Awards for participation (medals, trophies, cups, etc); and
- Awards for notable achievements (fight of the night, performance of the night, etc).
